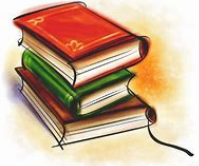
MAINTENANCE

During the storm & high winds on Tuesday, our main shade sail ripped. Shade people from Stawell will be collecting it this weekend to repair.

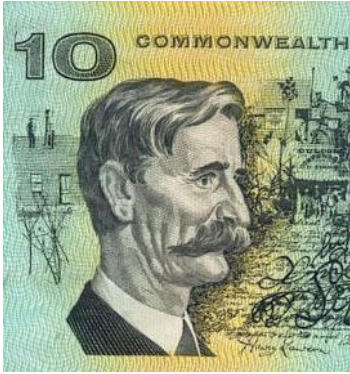
MARC

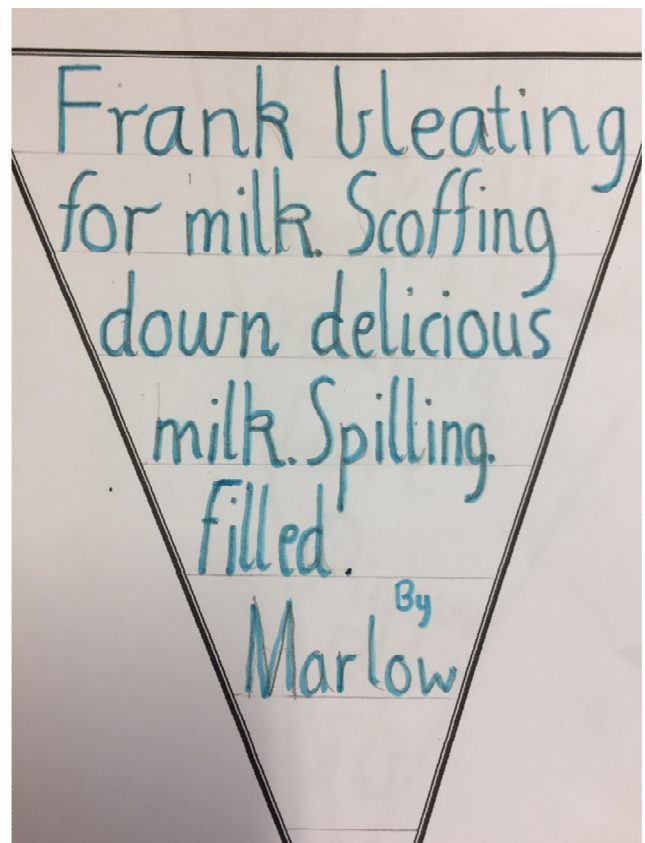
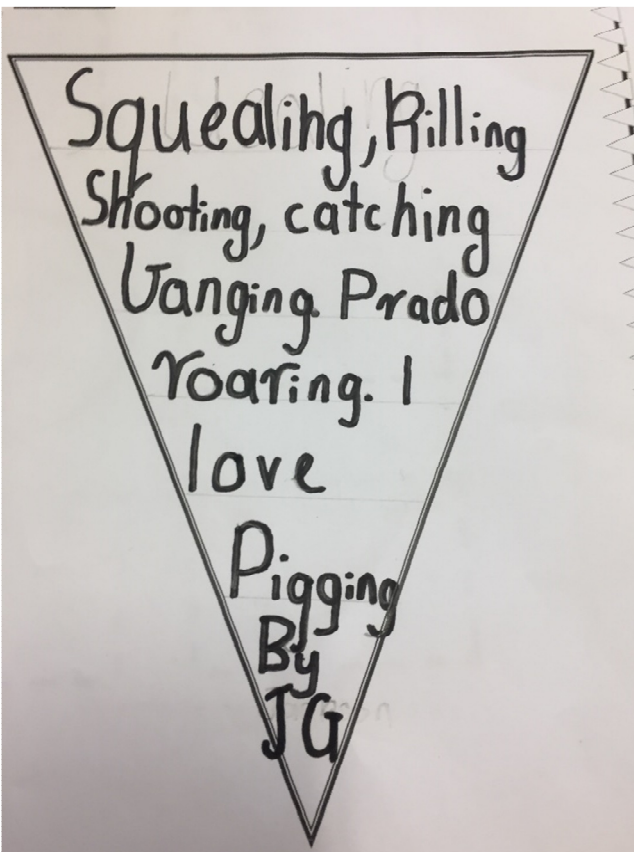
150 YEARS MEETING
